- FAST: PM3 (Florida Assessments for Student Thinking)
 - Subjects tested: FAST Reading & FAST Mathematics
 - I session in I day
 - All computer-based exams
- *Grade 5 ONLY- Science Statewide Assessment
 - I session in I day
 - Computer-based exam

Students in Grades K-2 will test remotely.

Students will test 3 times per year to monitor student progress

- PMI: Beginning of school year
- PM2: Mid-year
- PM3: End of school year

PM1 & PM2 are informal assessments, completed during class time PM3: Formal evaluation used for school accountability

*All remote testing

K-2 will test remotely on specific dates. E-mail will be sent with Zoom ID and test dates

OVERVIEW GRADES K-2

EARLY LITERACY, STAR READING & MATHEMATICS

Students will test 3 times per year to monitor student progress

- PMI: Beginning of school year
- PM2: Mid-year
- PM3: End of school year

PMI & PM2 are informal assessments, completed during class time *Remote testing

PM3: Formal evaluation used for school accountability

* *PM3 ONLY IN PERSON testing FOR GRADES 3-5.

OVERVIEW GRADES 3-5

FAST READING & MATHEMATICS

- Grades 4 & 5 students <u>MUST</u> take the B.E.S.T.Writing
- Computer-based Exam
- In-person exam only
- Testing window- April 1-12
- Scores will be reported separate from FAST Reading exam

All Kindergarten and Grade I students will take the Star Early Literacy for PMI. If a student scores at or above 852 on Star Early Literacy, the student will take Star Reading on subsequent administrations.





TESTING REMINDERS

- Arrive to testing site no later than 8:00am and report to the Main Office.
- Bring school ID (if student has one)
- Students <u>MUST</u> wear full school uniform. Students without full uniform will not be allowed into building
 - Plain white polo
 - Khaki or navy blue pants only- NO JEANS
- Bring #2 pencils.
- Sweaters are highly recommended.
- Bring snacks, lunch and water
- <u>Dismissal from school</u>: Parent/guardian must pick up the student. If someone else is picking up the student, they must send an e-mail to Ms. Iglesias prior to test date for approval.

TESTING REMINDERS (CTND)

- Every effort should be made to ensure that your child is present on the dates they are assigned to test.
 - Make-up dates may not be available or may require different location in order to accommodate
- Electronic devices are grounds for invalidation
- We ask that you please be flexible if changes to test dates take place.
 - Some schools will make changes to their testing dates due to unforeseen circumstances
 - You will receive a notification from us.
